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Conclusion of the Assessment and Recommendations of the Assessment Team

The purpose of the site assessment was to verify compliance with the requirements of the IECEx Scheme for the initial and on-going acceptance of an Ex Certification Body (ExCB). The site assessment forms part of the overall evaluation of the body by the IECEx Management Committee, ExMC and was conducted in accordance with the IECEx Scheme Assessment Procedures, IECEx OD 501. Report of the on-site assessment team is as follows:

The Assessment Team findings indicate QPS has Policies, Procedures and Operational requirements in place that verify compliance with ISO/IEC 17024 and the remaining IECEx CoPC Scheme Rules and Operational Documents. Given that QPS is not 17024 accredited it is recommended that a review be conducted in approximately 12 months from the date of acceptance to verify the operation is compliant with both the Policies and Procedures of the ExCB and also meets the requirements of the IECEx CoPC Scheme.

This should focus on the selection of assessors and the facilities/materials for the knowledge assessment being used and a review of the certification/assessment files.

The Assessment Team recommend QPS be accepted as a CoPC ExCB within the IECEx System.
